Summary:

1. Left ventricle: The cavity size is normal. Moderate LV hypertrophy is noted. There is moderate concentric hypertrophy. Systolic function is normal. The estimated ejection fraction is 60%. Wall motion is normal; there are no regional wall motion abnormalities.
2. Right ventricle: The cavity size is normal. Systolic function is normal.
3. Pulmonary arteries: Systolic pressure is 30-35 mm Hg.
4. Tricuspid valve: There is mild-moderate regurgitation.
